



## Albert F Currier

October 15, 1931 - February 8, 2023

Mr. Albert Field Currier, 91, a resident of Bonita Springs Florida, passed away peacefully just before noon on Wednesday, February 8, 2023. He left this life in the comfort of his residence, surrounded by his beloved family.

Born on Thursday, October 15, 1931 in Westtown, New York, he was the last surviving of ten children to the late Clarence Willard and Elsie Mae (Smith) Currier. He was educated in Orange County, New York.

Following his formal education, Mr. Currier proudly served our country with the United States Navy during the Korean Conflict, earning the rank of Petty Officer Second Class at the time of his Honorable Discharge from Military duties.
