



Deacon Albert J. Loeffler

August 19, 1931 - December 5, 2020

Deacon Albert Joseph H. Loeffler, age 89 of Middletown, NY, born in Baltimore, MD, entered into eternal rest Saturday, December 5, 2020.

Albert spent his life in service to his Catholic faith, family, and country. Albert served his faith first as an altar boy, then as a Leader of Song and Eucharistic Minister before being ordained as a Deacon in 2000. Albert and his wife devoted their lives to living and raising their children in the Catholic faith. Their faith brought them together as they met at a CYO dance in 1954. He served in the U.S. Navy on the aircraft carrier the USS Roosevelt during the Korean War. After working in the retail industry for many years, he retired from the Middletown Psychiatric Center.

All who knew Al knew of his sense of humor, quick wit, and love of cooking and music, much to our mother's chagrin. However, our mother's smile was always brightest while dancing with our dad.

Albert was the beloved father of seven children: Al Loeffler of Marina Del Rey, CA; Susan Ancona and her husband Peter of Middletown, NY; Eileen Purdy and her partner, Frank Mayle of New Paltz, NY; David Loeffler and his wife Madeleine of Milford, PA; Christopher Loeffler and his wife Tracie of Monroe, NY; Laura Werthmann and her husband Bob of Middletown, NY; and Mary Loeffler and her husband William Marcotte of Irvington, NY; 12 grandchildren

and 5 great-grandchildren. He is further survived by his sister, Mary Sobczynski of Manassas, VA and 12 nieces and nephews.

Albert was predeceased by his wife of 62 years, Marie in 2017, his parents Henry and Marie Dietz Loeffler; and one angel granddaughter, Jennifer Lynn Benedetto.

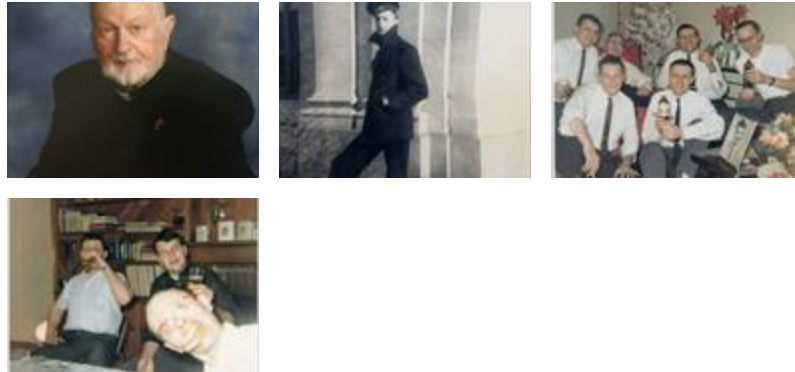
