She will be deeply missed by her children, grandchildren, extended family, friends, and all whose lives she touched. Her peaceful passing leaves a void that can never be filled, but her spirit will forever live on in the hearts of those she loved.

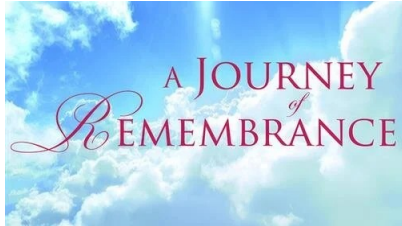

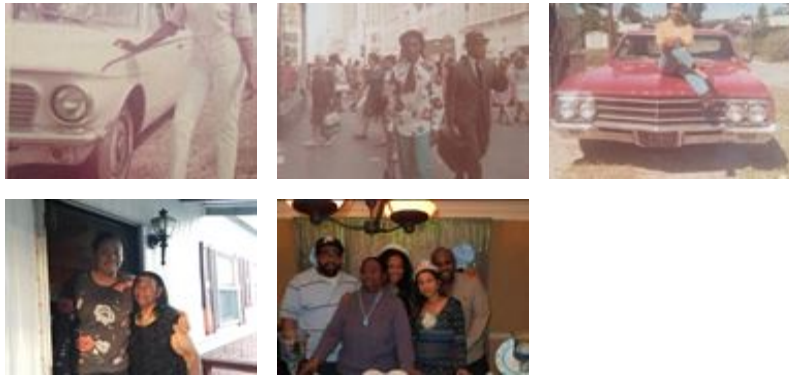
