She was the light of our family and the glue that held us all together.

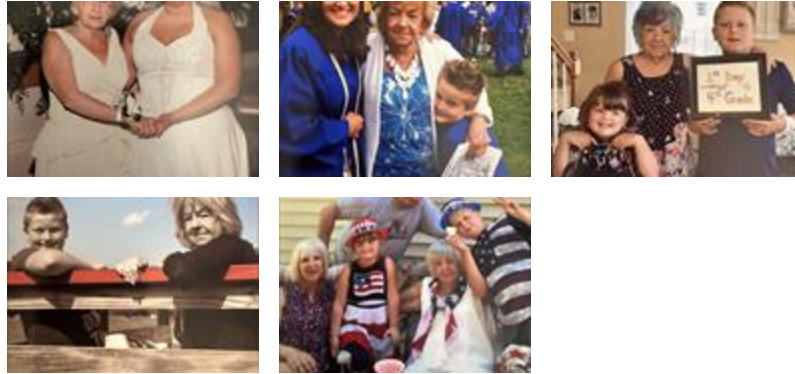

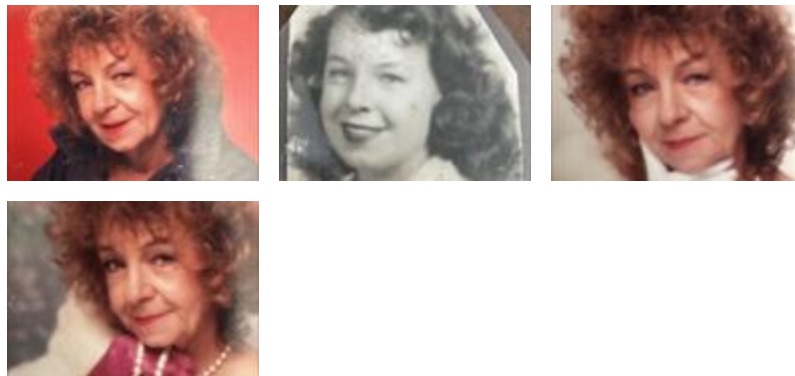
