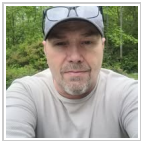

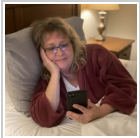

You are now back with Pop and your sister my friend give them both a hug and kiss for me until we see each other again.

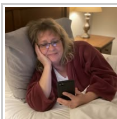
