Frederick Arthur Kelly, 74 of Pine Bush, New York passed away unexpectedly on November 15, 2022, at home. Born in Ellenville on January 24, 1948, New York to Leonie Frank-Scopteuolo and Hugh Kelly. He was a member of the local 417 Iron Workers Union.

He served in Vietnam from 1967-1969. A humble man, he would never regard himself as heroic, however he is a recipient of the Silver Star, Bronze Star, 3 purple hearts along with a number of other medals for he courageously saved others without regard for his own life.
