Jan Marie Davis, Middletown, NY, passed away on January 19th, 2026, at Garnet Hospital after complications from illness. She was 72 years old.

Jan was a registered nurse at Park Manor and specialized in Alzheimer and dementia care. She mentored generations of young nurses with gentle humor. She was an advocate for social causes and a fierce defender of people in need. Jan, an avid reader, had a quiet, unexpected, wicked sense of humor and was able to identify someone's character in moments.

She is survived by her son Raymond Carrier of Middletown, NY. Also surviving are her sisters, Susan Smith (John) of Saugerties, NY, Nora Pawelczak (John) of Florida, NY and Kim Dunmire of Middletown, NY, as well as several nieces and nephews.
