Joseph R. Turano was born in New York, New York on December 18, 1944, just as the Battle of the Bulge was being fought an ocean away. He is the only child to Josephine and Domenick Turano.

A man not afraid of hard work since he was 14 years old, he continued to do so until his mid 70's. His work experiences include driving a bus for the New York City Transit Authority for 24 years, from 1971 to 1995. As a bus operator, he had many stories about what he saw on the streets of the City in the 70's and 80's. They were enough to make a Scorsese film in it of itself. He was also cast as the driver of a city bus in the early '80's in the "I need a vacation" Florida commercials. He drove the bus but an actual actor that looked more like a bus driver was used because my father was told he was too good looking to be onscreen. On his routes he got to be friendly with various celebrities such as Jack Warden, who told him he should be an actor to having coffee with John Lennon at a diner near Central Park.

He was a kind and good man. He always made people laugh and his humor was contagious.

He is survived by his loving wife, Regina Turano, son Joseph D. Turano and granddaughter, Layla Esther Turano.
