Fallsburg, NY school district. Marge retired from the Las Vegas School System as a facilitator for the district establishing care plans for children.

Marge attended the Methodist church throughout her life and was a faithful servant to God and the church community. She loved to sing and was involved in various roles, even helping to found a church in North Las Vegas, NV.

Marge had the Mary Kay enthusiasm, selling those products for many years. She was a real people person and even towards the end of her life, she loved to make people smile with a joke or a compliment.
