It is with profound sadness that we announce the passing of Pamela Hagele, 70. She passed away peacefully in her sleep at home on Tuesday, June 24th, 2025. Pam was the devoted, loving wife of 28 magnificent years to Re Hagele. Re and Pam brought together and raised four wonderful children who will all miss her loving presence.

Born in Oakland, California, in February of 1955, she was the daughter of Paul and Lois

Spierling. Paul Spierling, a U.S. Navy Doctor (Navy Reserve CDR Ret.), moved the family to the East Coast town of Katonah, NY, when she was seven years old. She attended and graduated from John Jay High School in Cross River, NY, in 1973, and then went on to study nursing at Springfield University and the University of Massachusetts Amherst, where she graduated with a Bachelor of Science in Nursing in 1977.
