August 16, 1932 - February 28, 2023

Dr. Robert E. Weltman, “Dr. Bob”, passed away on Feb. 28, 2023, at home after a long illness. He was born Aug. 16, 1932, in Queens, NY, son of Nathan Weltman and Hortense Rubenstein. Upon graduating from NYU and Yeshiva University with a PhD, he moved to Middletown, NY, and started his psychology career at Middletown Psychiatric Center, where he met his wife of 49 years, Ruth Pennyfeather. After MPC he opened a private practice then moved on to Mid-Hudson Psychiatric Center where he became Principal Psychologist. Bob was noted for learning Doman-Delacato Patterning at CHOP in Philadelphia and bringing it back to Orange County in the middle 1960s to treat developmentally delayed patients. He was also a lifetime member of ARC. After retiring, Dr. Bob shifted towards spiritual healing through prayer and shared this by books and devotionals he wrote, a website, volunteer prayer groups in the OC Jail and a local weekly radio show. He was kindhearted and making the world better was close to him. Additional interests were handball, tennis, Benny Goodman, writing and his favorite TV channel... TCM. Dr. Bob was predeceased by his loving wife Penny and is survived by three children, David Weltman at home, Matthew Weltman (Jill) from Greenwood Lake, NY, and Miah Usmani (Casey) from Middletown, VA. He is also survived by 3 grandchildren Dana, Silken and Logan, 1 great granddaughter Chloe and 1 cat Bumper. Special thanks to Annie, Geena and Jess who were a big help and are like family! 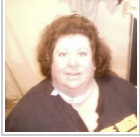
