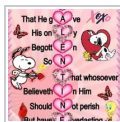

When I walked in the door at 105 route 22 in Johnson NY, she would meet me at the door, if she was able, with a sweet smile and hello Bill. As the years went by I came to know her very well and could always tell when she wasn't feeling well. I couldn't always assess her by information she provided me with because she would almost always say "i'm doing OK". She was stubborn and independent, I would kneel by her side and drag the information I needed to treat her. Some days, that was not very easy and she made me work, but that sweet smile was ever present. The many times I treated her in the back of our ambulance I learned much about her. I learned about her love for life and the love she shared with her family and friends. No matter how poorly she felt she would always ask me how I was feeling. We shared a lot of memories and I will miss her dearly. she could always put a little sunshine in my life when I could see nothing but clouds. Your toil on earth is over and it is time for you to rest, but you will never be forgotten. You knew that I would never say goodbye for I believe that means forever and I would not see someone again. I always part with "Later", for that means I will see you again. So sticking with my normal I will not say goodbye.....only Later Susan.

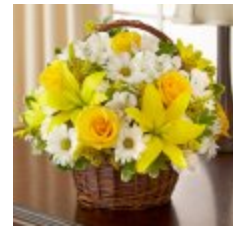
