Victoria Vickie Ann Lassiter, age 74 passed away peacefully on January 25, 2026, at her home in Middletown NY.

She earned her GED and became a Credentialed Alcoholism and Substance Abuse Counselor (CASAC), dedicating more than 20 years of her life to helping individuals and families affected by addiction. Her work was grounded in compassion, honesty, and an unwavering belief in recovery.

A devoted member of Narcotics Anonymous and Alcoholics Anonymous, Vickie celebrated 35 years of Sobriety. She proudly shared her journey to inspire others and stood as a living testament to perseverance and hope.

An entrepreneur at heart, Victoria was the Founder and CEO of Beyond Your Wildest Dreams Productions, working in the entertainment industry with vision and determination. She was also a well-known and beloved street vender on 125th Street in Harlem under the name Victoria Scents, where she touched countless lives with her warmth, humor, and vibrant personality.

Creatively gifted she was known for her Tee shirts and beautiful butterfly

collages-symbols of transformation that reflected her own journey. Affectionately known as “LadyV” and “Queen” she carried herself with confidence, humor and grace.

Victoria “Vickie” Ann Lassiter is survived by her loving daughters, Malicka and Lukricia; her spiritual brothers and sisters, nieces and nephews; aunts and cousins; and a host of extended family members and friends who will forever cherish her memory.
