January 28, 1943 - June 20, 2024

William M. Fields Sr., a former longtime resident of Greenwood Lake, N.Y. passed away on June 20, 2024, in Westchester Medical Center after a brief battle with cancer. He was 81. The son of the late William Martin Fields and Mary Murphy Fields, he was born on January 28, 1943, in Bronx, N.Y. He married his high school sweetheart, Kathleen Mary Donald on November 17, 1962, just four days after she turned eighteen. They spent 50 years together until her passing in January 2013.
