# Tribute Wall



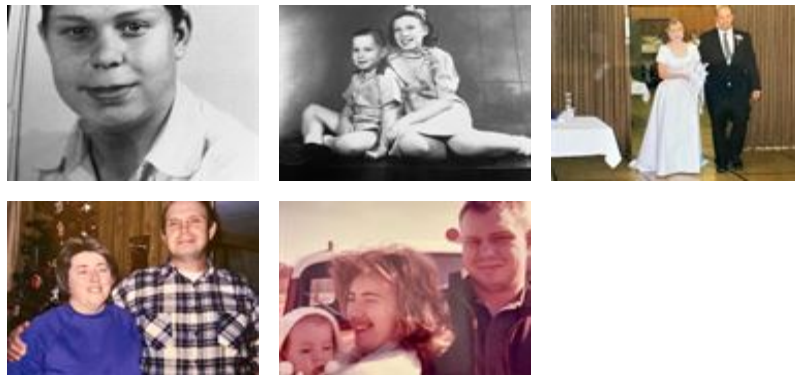

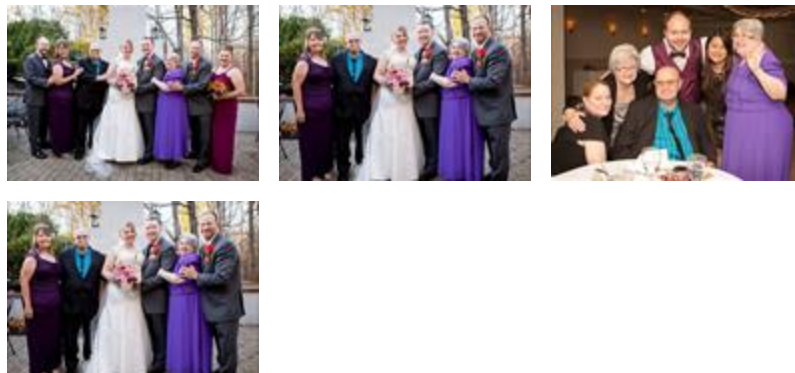
